“Rooted in Love”—Tune into WBCI 105.9 FM for the radio program, “Rooted in Love”, each Saturday morning at 10:30 am.

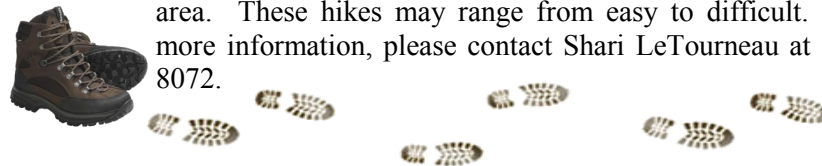
